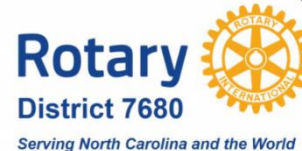
Our district:

Very near our District are the Blue Ridge Mountains.

You can visit Chimney Rock via the Blue Ridge Parkway and overlook the river. Many folks hike Mount Mitchell, the highest peak in eastern North America.
